Outline For Final Exam and Final AICE Essays

You need to find the themes and subthemes on the website. The themes that are done are themes: Theme 1 Westward Expansion and the Taming of the West 1840-1896, Theme 2 Civil War and Reconstruction 1861-1877, and Theme 6 The USA's Rise as a World Power, 1890-1945. The student is also responsible for the Theme Causes of the Civil War for the Source Based Essay. If the student did an outline for the essay that covers the subtheme it may be inserted and utilized for that subtheme outline. Each section needs to be labeled by the theme, subtheme and numbered. The outline for the subthemes should also be numbered as below 1-4. Due date is May 28th for 3rd period, May 30th for 5th period, and May 24th for 7th period.

The follow should be done for each subtheme under themes 1, 2, and 6:

- 1. Define the topic.
- 2. When did it take place?
- 3. 10 facts about each topic
- 4. 3 pros and 3 negative effects of the topic

(Make sure that any terms, people, and laws are clearly defined in the section.)

Theme 1 has 11 sections, theme 2 has 19 sections and theme 6 has 16 sections = 46 sections. This section is worth 90% of the total score.

In addition to these 46 sections you need to complete source based information on the Civil War. The following needs to be done to this section:

- 1. Select 10 causes to the Civil War and list them.
- 2. Define 10 terms included in this topic
- 3. Identify 10 people who were important to this topic
- 4. Select 4 topics that moved the Civil War forward and 4 topics that held it off.

This section is worth 10 % of the total score.

The exam is scored in the following manner: 70% on completion of all material 25% on quality of the work 5% organized and easy to follow
