## Zachary Taylor (1849-1850)

- -1 term in office
- -Mexican war hero
- -Early 1850 led conference with southern states who threathened secession
- -At July 4th ceremonies he ate cherries and milk, and fell in. Within five days he died
- -Richard, his son, served as a general in the Confederate Army

## Millord Fillmore (1850-1853)

- -1 term in office
- -Succeeded from Vice President, on the death of Zachary Taylor
- -Compromise of 1850
- -Vice president-none
- Secretary of state, Daniel Webster (1850-1852), Edward Everett (1852-1853)
- -Fugitive Slave Act-1852
- Myth- Fillmore installed the first bathtub in the white house
- Last U.S. president who was neither Democrat or Republican (except Abe Lincoln, Union Ticket)
- Fillmore, Utah was named after him
- Bill to admit California to the Union
- Sent Stephen Douglas of Ilinoise presented 5 bills to congress:
  - 1. Admit California as a free state
  - 2. Settle the Texas boundary and compensate.
  - 3. Grant tweeitoiral staus to New Mexica
  - 4. Place Federal officers at the disposal of slaveholders seeking fugitives.
  - 5. Abolish slave trade in the district of Columbia
- -Died March 8, 1874
