William Henry Harrison (1773-1841)

Terms In Office

President Harrison was unable to complete a full term in office.

Election Results

Won by a majority of less than 150,000, but won the Electoral College votes 234-60.

Four Ideas or Acts Passed During Administration

President Harrison was unable to pass any acts or ideas due to his untimely death (not due to his age, just the fact that he was just elected president less than a month earlier)

Two Problems Encountered

Pneumonia

Harrison was the oldest elected president at 68, until 140 years later, Reagan was elected at 69.

Harrison was a member of the Whig party and when he died so did their political campaigns.

Harrison was considered to be a war hero and was nick named "Tippecanoe" (or "Old Tippecanoe") after he defeated the Native Americans at the Battle of Tippecanoe in 1811.
